PATHWAY 3

Pathway 3 is a curriculum for students who believe a more vocational approach to learning is recommended.

Following its successful introduction in September 2011, Pathway 3 is a model based around three individual and specific 'Routeways', with each providing a complete package to prepare learners for careers within either a care setting career, a construction/engineering career or a career in hospitality and catering.

Here, students will pick only ONE routeway most appropriate to their desired career or future area of interest and follow that area for eight contact periods per week.

The course will be supported with additional subjects including ICT, P.E., employability skills and of course Mathematics, English and Science. Students will also achieve an award in Wider Key Skills. Upon completion, learners achieving an award in their chosen routeway will be well prepared for either further education (i.e. continuing on into Burnside Sixth Form) or employment/apprenticeship. Work Experience is also included within each routeway.
